several Open, Regional and State cook-offs all become popular places to compete for points and maybe even obtain one of those auto-qualifying positions. The US Open, Texas Ladies' State, Texas Men's State, Louisiana State, North Carolina and Kansas State Championships are on the immediate horizon along with several Pod cook-offs. Springtime seems to be when the road opens wide towards TICC.

Spring is also the time of year when certain aspects of the administrative side of CASI starts to open. First, applications for the 2025 US National Open are now being accepted. The application can be found on the CASI website under "Organizational Information" or visit <a href="https://casichili.fun/usno">https://casichili.fun/usno</a>. The deadline for applying is May 1, 2024. Applications for the CASI Board of Directors are also open and can be found on the GPM page of the CASI website (<a href="https://www.casichili.net/2024-gpm.html">https://www.casichili.net/2024-gpm.html</a>). The deadline for

applying for directorship is July 1, 2024.


Another important item that only occurs every three years is proposing any changes to CASI's Rule Book. The proposed rule change template with a completed example form is posted on the CASI GPM webpage. This time of year is when we should be putting serious thought into what changes should be proposed for the GP's to discuss and vote on in September. It can be the

addition of a new rule or clarification to the language of an existing rule. Remember, the rule book is only opened once every three years. When considering a proposed change to the rule book, be mindful of how it affects the organization as a whole and not just one specific area. Think about how a proposed change affects not only me, my Pod, region, or state, but how it affects every cook, every Pod, every region, and every state. Please work with your Great Pepper on any changes you think are viable and worthy of discussion at the GPM. More information on proposed rule changes will be communicated to

the Great Peppers. Please add this important item to your Pod meeting agendas in the upcoming months.

In closing, Spring is an exciting time for me and I hope it is for you as well. It is when adventure starts to ramp up as we head into CASI's busy season. Thanks and see you out on the Chili Trail sometime soon!





## Make No Mistake: Cup Advancement and Distribution

The procedure for advancing judging cups through the judging process is rather straightforward, and pretty well defined in the CASI Rules. However, there are areas where room for judgment is allowed. Make no mistake, the premise of our rules is accuracy, integrity, and fairness. That should always be a head judge's mindset.

Rule II.B says that judging will be done using preliminary and final judges; not completely accurate. I think everyone understands that for small cook-offs, e.g., twenty or fewer cooks, would only use final judges. What this rule does not say, is that each table in a round should have the same number of judges. This can be an issue if a judge does not show up, but every attempt should be made to keep the tables within a round equal.

Rule II.C addresses cup advancement through the various

rounds of judging. Make no mistake, it is very important that the cups be distributed equally among the tables. It is a mathematical reality that this can be done with  $a \pm of$  one cup. That's equal enough. It is also very important to keep in mind that a minimum of 50% of the cups must advance from each judging table.

Let us use a cook-off with twenty-five cooks as an example of where some judgments come in. At this example cook-off, you would have two rounds of judging. Since there is an odd number of cooks, equally dividing the cups would mean one table would have twelve cups and the other table thirteen. Providing there were no ties, advancing 50% of the cups would leave you with thirteen chilis, one below the *minimum* final table requirement of fourteen chilis. Keeping fairness in mind, advancing more than 50% would make good sense. Given this situation, I would aim to advance eight cups from each table, and if there are ties, you could wind up with eighteen cups on the final table. If no ties, I would take nine cups. A final table of seventeen to twenty cups is a fair representation of the cooks. There are many numerical combinations, so we simply must rely on the head judge to make a good decision.

Throughout my thirty-nine year CASI career, there have been many people who have influenced my development to whom I am greatly indebted. *One of the most important of those was Jim Stateczny.* I was greatly saddened by his passing and want to express my sincere condolences to Shirley and the family.

I became acquainted with Jim in the late nineties when he was a CASI Director. However, when

I became TallyMaster in 2001, we *really* got acquainted. In those days, the TallyMaster program was on a laptop computer. My monthly results file, which looked like gibberish, was sent to Jim who turned it into something printable in the *Terlingua Trails*. After Jim


developed the CIS software, my life got a lot easier.

Who is not familiar with the CASI Tally Program that Jim developed for CASI, free of charge? Or the CASI National Scholarship Program that was the brainchild of Jim along with Tom Williams and Jim Ezell? Make no mistake, Jim has meant a lot to CASI and to me personally. 
