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It's Almost Summer

The biggest change this year is the deadline for applications to run for the CASI Board of Directors. It is now July 1. There are four Directors whose terms end in September: Mary Ellen Gillen, Nancy Hewlett, Kit Rudd and Allan 'Scotty' Parker. At the time of this writing, Mary Ellen has announced that she will not be seeking another term.

If you have thought about contributing to CASI in a new way, I encourage you to contact a sitting director, get their take on serving on the Board and make your decision. CASI needs all the diversity, creativity, imagination and dedication to service that it can possibly get. Since we are an all-volunteer organization, we depend on those dedicated individuals who step up and donate their time and talent to help our organization continue to move forward. It has been a rewarding experience for me, and I appreciate the support and dedication from our membership.

There is still time in the year to help our Scholarship Fund by hosting a *Kids Cooking For Kids* event. This

is a program that is very close to my heart and means a great deal to me. It's a great way to get those junior cooks involved and donate to worthy causes. The entry fees from your *Kids Cooking For Kids* cookoff are matched dollar for dollar by Michael and me.

The stipulations are you must advertise that it is a *Kids Cooking For Kids* cookoff, and the kids' entry fees are designated for the CASI Scholarship Fund. You must contact me with the date of your cookoff so that I can send you a little something for your junior cooks. Once the cookoff is over, contact me with your kids' entry fee total, and we'll get the ball rolling.

I was asked about the payment part of this. You can't send in this payment with your regular cookoff fees. You will send a separate check to me made out to the *CASI Scholarship Fund*. Once received, both payments are mailed to the CASI treasurer and credited to the scholarship fund. My address is located on the CASI website and on the inside back page of the *Trails*.

After much consideration and talking to many people, we are moving the Le Grande Tour de Poivre (the lighted golf cart parade) to Tuesday evening this year. With the multitude of events scheduled on Wednesday evening, it is time for the change. Since most participants are cooking at their camps on Tuesday for *Cookin' for CASI*, this is a great time to decorate your golf carts. The parade times will still be the same – line up at 8pm, parade at 9pm and party, party, party at the Crazy Flats Saloon afterwards. I know that moving it earlier in the week will not fit in to everyone's schedule, but I think that with the day change, it will ease some of the time constraints on Wednesday. The parade theme is *St. Patrick's Day Beirt*.

In closing, I thank you for all you have done and continue to do. Have a great summer, safe travels and enjoy your time on the trail with friends and family.



Make No Mistake!

This month's topic is open. The word 'open' is a very common word and has many definitions. It can be an adjective, *i.e.*, allowing access or a view. It can be a verb, *i.e.*, the act of allowing an access or view. And it can be a noun, *i.e.*, a championship or competition without restrictions on who may enter. This is

how CASI uses the word, and will be the point of this discussion.

CASI actually has a whole section devoted to 'open' – VI. CASI Open Championships – and the second rule, VI.A.2 defines 'open' as it applies to CASI. CASI Open Championships must allow an unlimited number of entrants. However, we do have some restrictions; cooks must meet CASI age and gender requirements. Additionally, Rule V.A.5a uses 'open' as a verb when it states that all sanctioned cookoffs must be open to at least 50 entrants.

A few years ago it used to be easy to explain to people that all automatic qualifying cookoffs were open championships. But then along came the rule (VII.E.1g) that give the Pod Cookoff champion an automatic qualification. Pod cookoffs are not open championships, thus the rules in section VI do not apply.

Caution! The last five words, "regardless of number of cooks," might be misleading. Make no mistake, you must have a minimum of 15 cooks to get your pod cookoff sanctioned.

Quite often, when a cookoff promoter has a cookoff for the locals without adhering to CASI Rules, it is called an 'open division.' This is a confusing use of the term, even more so when that local cookoff is part of an actual CASI Open Championship. There are many other ways to name those cookoffs, such as 'homestyle,' 'traditional' or 'local.' But we have no jurisdiction over those cookoffs so all we can do is suggest a different name.

So make no mistake, when you see a CASI cookoff listed as an open championship, it is open to all and is an automatic qualifier of three or more cooks.

Of late, the folks of the CASI computer group have used the word 'open' to define the type of meat lacking restrictions. When listing a cookoff you will be presented with a drop-down to choose: 'Open,' 'Chili Grind,' or 'Cut Meat,' with the default being Chili Grind. All CASI cookoffs start without restrictions on the type of meat that can be used. Rule V.A.2 does allow a cookoff promoter to place, and enforce, restrictions on various aspect of their cookoff. So, make no mistake, when you see or use the word 'open,' make sure it is used properly.



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
