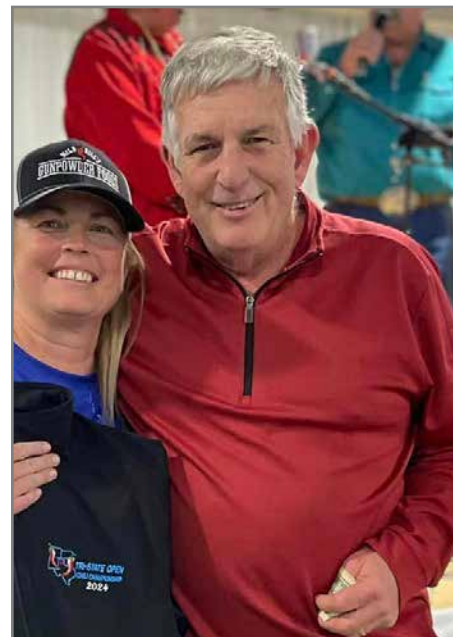

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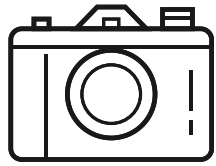
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Quick Takes from the Chili Trail

Make No Mistake: Can You Wear Two Hats or Just One?

CASI Rule VI.A.4 explains that Open Championships must have a Regional Referee, Great Pepper, or designee acting as Head Judge. This is reasonable, we want people very

knowledgeable of CASI Rules to be the Head Judge of major events. The rule goes on to say that an Open Championship cook-off Referee must be a person other than that Head Judge. Again a reasonable requirement. This would seem to suggest that at other, regular cook-offs, the Head Judge and cook-off Referee may be one in the same individual. From a practical standpoint, this is acceptable. Especially

at small cook-offs where personnel is limited.



However, I remember a very wise Executive Director, Hut Brown, telling me that it is not a good idea for one person to do both jobs. The reason being; the Referee's job is to make sure the Head Judge does his job. *Make no mistake, while it is legal for one person to be both Head Judge and Referee, there are better options.*



A 2021 rule change permitted a person who did

cook that day to announce the winning numbers. The reason for that change was because at very small cook-offs, it is likely that there is no one around who did not cook to do the announcing. However, the rule requires additional non-cooks to handle the judging cups, remove the tickets, and verify the ticket numbers. Hmmm? Make no mistake, if personnel is scarce, one non-cook could do all four of those tasks. I would entertain feedback on how that is working out.

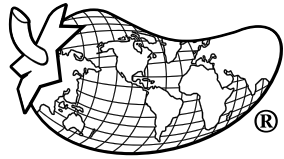
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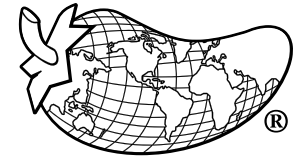

When you do not request a rule book or tickets, you will not be mailed a packet. You will instead receive an email with the necessary forms for the cookoff. Please print out the forms and be sure to fill in your event number, date, name and place.

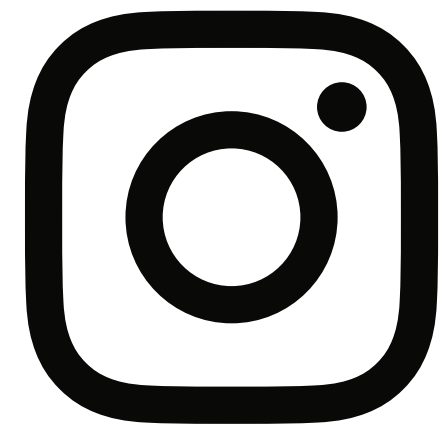

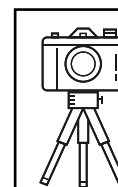
